

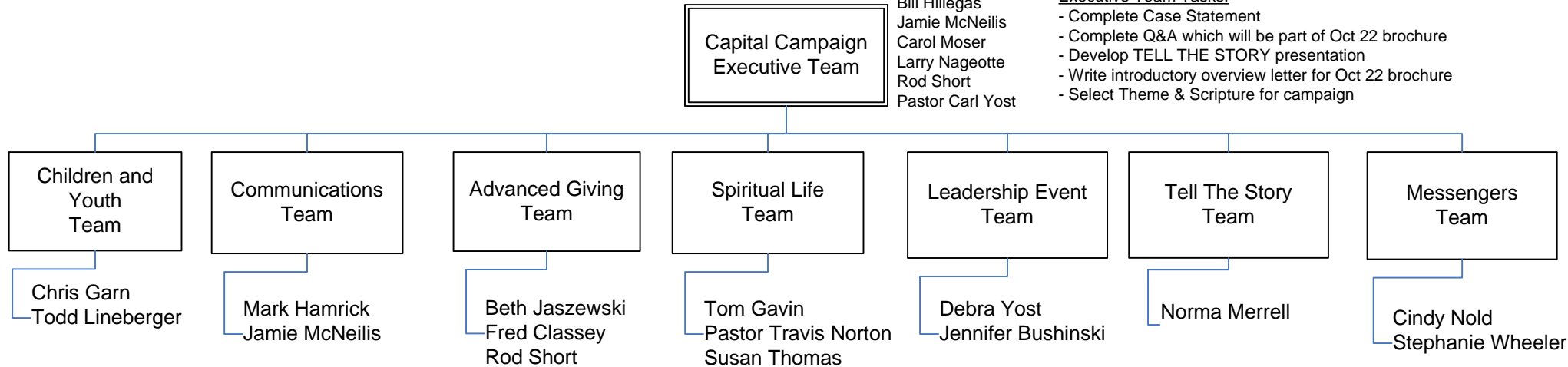

Executive Team Tasks:

- Complete Case Statement
- Complete Q&A which will be part of Oct 22 brochure
- Develop TELL THE STORY presentation
- Write introductory overview letter for Oct 22 brochure
- Select Theme & Scripture for campaign



Energize the children and youth and use the campaign as a learning and fellowship opportunity for them.

The pieces we know about so far to be developed for print/email/web distribution are:
Oct 22- Initial Overview: 4 page brochure including ExTeam intro letter/vision and goals, campaign events schedule (hopefully with Tell the Story events), initial Q&A
Nov 4- Distribution of Campaign Brochure at Kickoff worship: includes graphic depiction of Case Statement, goals, TTS schedule, letter from Pastor/ Executive Directors, more Q&A, Devotional Booklet
Nov 30- Response packet with letter, giving guide, and commitment cards.

Also work with Executive team to develop Power Point presentation for TELL THE STORY and other event use.

Review list of 50 with Executive Team. Determine who from this list will assist as either visitors or presenters at a group gathering (3-5 couples). Begin making decisions about who on the list should have an individual visit (and who should be their visitor), and any natural groupings that you might bring together for a group presentation.

Invite all those who will be visitors or presenters to an orientation session with David M. We should make our assignments to carry out these 50 contacts. Contacts during November.

Invite at least 35 members to provide a daily devotion for booklet to be distributed Nov 4. These devotions can use self-selected Bible passages and cover any area of one's faith journey (spiritual growth, discipleship, stewardship, etc). Prepare a brief instruction of what you want people to do, choose a sample, and do a template for a one page passage/text/ prayer. Have them emailed to a collector/editor who will assemble and send to Communications Team.

Plan for Spiritual Life options during the campaign. Consider prayer journey around building, prayer vigils, prayer partners, and Sunday morning and Wednesday evening opportunities.

Prepare an invitation list for the Leadership Dinner/ Party on Dec 1 (?). Work with the Executive Team to decide who should be on this list (including those identified for Advance Gifts phase). When details are known, send invitations. Work with Executive team to coordinate agenda (mostly the TELL THE STORY presentation).

Consider venue and date for the Leadership Event.

Goal is to create a variety of fun/fellowship events to "Tell the Story" of the CIC vision and mission at the heart of this campaign. We want to involve at least 125-200 CIC families.

Make decisions and schedule the events during November, getting the schedule to Communications Team ASAP. When schedule is complete, create a strategy for inviting people in a personal way to insure reaching participation goals.

Select tri-team leaders. Each of these tri-leaders will invite 10-12 Messengers (enough so that each Messenger will call 10-12 families) to an orientation session with David M. Messengers will each have a list of 10-12 families to contact twice during the campaign (week of Oct 29 and week of Dec 3)

Update list of all CIC families and regular attendees who will be contacted. Once you confirm this list, consider ways to divide the list into lists of 10-12 families (current small groups, hoped for new groups, inactive/less active, etc).

Should have these lists prepared and ready to distribute at the orientation session.
